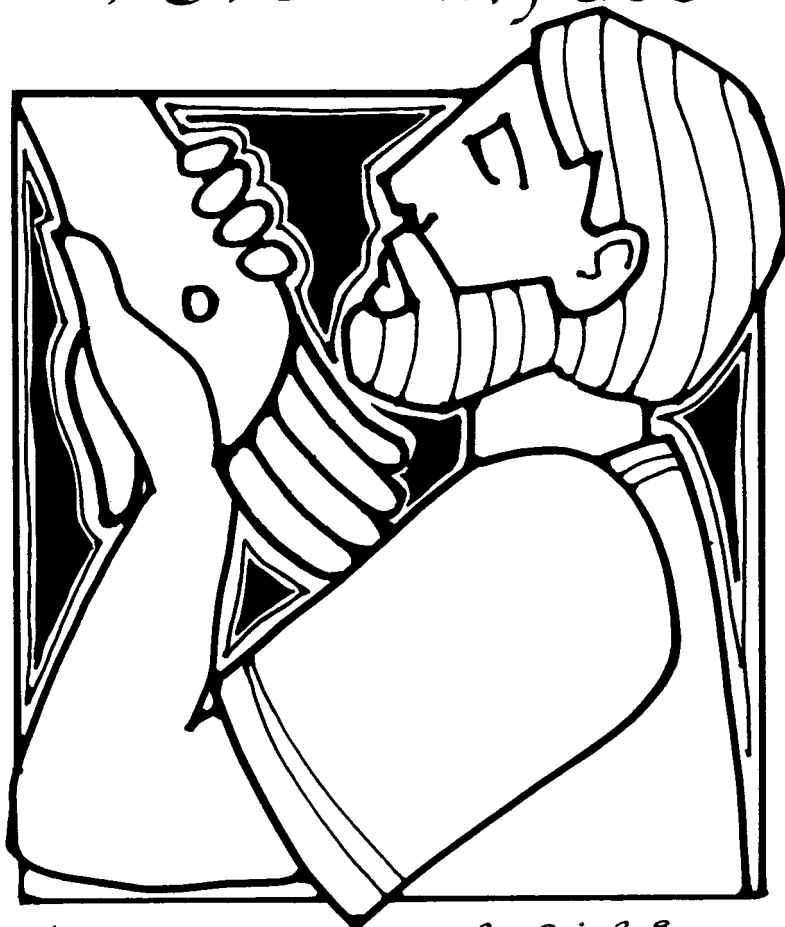

NOTES FOR IN-BUILDING WORSHIP

- 1) PLEASE **DO NOT** ARRIVE BEFORE 8:45 am unless you are ushering or otherwise directly involved in the worship service.
- 2) Please wear your mask, use hand sanitizer, keep your distance!
- 3) Ushers will seat you based on your reservation and Smart Team guidelines; remain in your seat, please, unless directed otherwise. Offering plates will be at the doors.
- 4) Holy Communion will happen at the end of the service. You will be directed, by household, towards the exit (take your coat with you!) to receive the elements as you leave. The rich theology behind this will be “food for the journey”. Appropriate safety precautions will be in place and directions given prior to this happening during the service.
- 5) We will not yet be sharing coffee or goodies or shaking hands. Bathrooms will be available, if needed.
